## *Write-The-Word*

The pages that follow are provided in dotted handwriting to encourage you to write out God's word and hide it in your heart. When you slow down and meditate on the Word as you write, you'll find yourself relaxing, pondering, and memorizing along your learning journey. The graphics in the margins allow you the freedom create art as you complete this simple workbook.

If you only have access to a pencil, repeatedly trace over words you want to highlight. If you have a pen, colored pencils or highlighters, use them to enhance your artistic expression.

Here are some ideas you might consider as you meditate on God's word:

Simply trace all the words pondering the teaching as you write:

*To give subtilty to the simple*

Trace then darken parts of the verse you feel are the most important:

*A wise man will hear,*

Trace then darken parts that draw you closer to God:

*The fear of the LORD is  
the beginning of knowledge*

Trace then darken commands that speak to your heart/mind:

*forsake not the law  
of your mother*

Trace then darken parts of you want to remember:

*if sinners entice you,  
consent you not*

Trace then darken reminders of faith:

*Trust in the LORD  
with all your heart;*

Trace then bubble outline words you want to notice:

***whoever** hearkens to me  
shall dwell safely*

Trace then add doodle art:

*Then shall they call upon  
me, **but** I will **not** answer*
